- 21 **Gold Country Colombard Chardonnay** 2 £19.60
A dry aromatic wine with zingy acidity and enhanced floral character. Predominantly from French Colombard, Chenin Blanc and Chardonnay.
- 22 **Gold Country Cabernet Sauvignon** C £19.60
A soft fruity easy-to-drink red wine ideal with red meats and cheese.
- 23 **Buffalo Ridge Zinfandel Rosé** 4 £18.50
Medium dry, blush wine with fragrant floral notes and orange blossoms with ripe berry flavours and a crisp, medium dry finish.

Argentina

- 24 **Caoba Chardonnay** 2 £19.80
Golden yellow with olive green tinges. Floral reminders of rose and violets, with a touch of citric notes. Fresh, light-bodied with delicate tropical fruits.
- 25 **Alto de Mayo Malbec** C £20.95
This Malbec is crammed with damson, blackberry and plum flavours, accented by touches of oak toast. Smooth, ripe tannins offer a silky finish.
- 26 **Pascual Toso, Estate Malbec** D £31.20
Ripe fruits on the nose with aromas of plums and quince and a touch of elegant oak. Blackberry and liquorice fruit on the palate lead onto a rich and long finish with smoky accents of vanilla and lingering oak.

Portugal

- 27 **Altano Douro Organic Red** C £28.55
This rich flavoursome wine is made from the two traditional Port grape varieties- Tinta Roriz and Touriga Franca. Deep in colour and part matured in oak, the wine is warm, ripe, and spicy.

England

- 28 **Sharpham Dart Valley Reserve** 2 £24.80
Made from the Madelaine Angevine grape and from an excellent vintage. It has a delightful spritz, fresh fruit flavours and a vibrant citrus mouthfeel.

- 29 **Piesporter Riesling Michelsberg** 4 £18.10
Soft medium dry wine with a good balance and soft fruity finish.

France

Alsace

- 30 **Gewurztraminer Cuvée Michel Léon** 3 £32.10
Rich and powerful, very aromatic with hints of flowers and spices.

Loire

- 31 **Sancerre Blanc Salmon** 1 £43.40
Less herbaceous than most Sancerre's, soft tones of ripe gooseberry back with mineral flavours, reflecting the vineyards it comes from. Very appealing.

Red Rhone

- 32 **Cotes Du Rhone Pasquier des Vignes** C £24.35
Magnificent violet and black nose on spices and black fruit maturity. Mouth concentrated, rich, dense, lovely ripe fruit with sweet tannins.
- 33 **Chateauneuf Du Pape Domaine Condorcet** D £45.90
A fine bouquet of berries and spices develops into a full rich rounded wine that will complement red meats and game.

White Burgundy

- 34 **Macon Lugny-Les Genievres Louis Latour** 2 £34.20
A beautiful nose of white fruit, and some peppery notes. This is a delicious wine with a round and full mouth, it shows distinctive aromas of white fruit, laced with floral notes.
- 35 **Chablis 1er Cru Domaine Du Colombier** 1 £55.50
Domaine bottled, this is an elegant dry white with aromas of ripe fruit and a full body giving a classic finish.

Red Burgundy

- 36 **Fleurie Chateau de L'Abbaye - Beaujolais** B £34.40
Supple and structured with silky tannins. Well balanced with a lively finish and lingering fruity aroma.
- 37 **Gevrey Chambertin Louis Jadot** C £84.80
Possibly the most famous of the great communes of the northern Côte de Nuits. These vineyards vary considerably in quality and the name of the producer is perhaps more important here than elsewhere. Louis Jadot wines are consistently reliable and long-lived with the full, rich structure for which this appellation is so famous.

Red Bordeaux

- 38 **Chateau Barrail Lussac Bordeaux** C £24.95
Complex, dominated by black pepper and fruity aromas (blueberry, raspberry and cherry). Well balanced with smooth tannins and a powerful spicy aftertaste.
- 39 **Chateau La Pointe Bouquey - St Emilion** C £33.10
The blend is 85% Merlot, 11% Cabernet Sauvignon and 4% Cabernet Franc. Deep garnet with a warm spiced bread and red fruit character powerful, yet supple; with vanilla aromas on the finish.
- 40 **La Closerie de Malescasse Haut Medoc** C £35.00
Well-ripened forest fruits are complemented by subtly toasted notes which elegantly underline a very fruity style. The palate is supple, rounded and silky, balanced by a liveliness which gives it great energy.

Sparkling

- 41 **Beau Rocher Brut Rose - Rosé** 3 £23.50
Harmonious, elegant and fresh with soft delicate undertones.
- 42 **Asti Spumante** 5 £23.50
Opulent and medium- sweet. Classic `Muscat` grape flavours.
- 43 **Prosecco Frizzante Spago Botter** 2 £25.65
A sweet apple and citrus flavour. It has a slight sweetness (off dry) which is very pleasing, and makes an ideal aperitif. It is presented "Al Spago" which means it has a cork secured with string.
